1.	 <b>Attention Z</b> <i>Jasmin Seppala-Geerink</i>	0 3	0%	36%	489	Nine-year-old horse still finding experience at these levels. This will be only the horses third time to jump at a level of 155 or above.
2.	 <b>Equine America Unick Du Francport</b> <i>John Whitaker</i>	3 18	17%	29%	655	John has won the Gothenburg Trophy in 1987 & 1990. They have contested 130 competitions at 5* 155/160 level together. Winning the 155 in New York in 2022.
3.	 <b>Damoiselle Du Mesnil</b> <i>Josefin Torell</i>	0 0			562	Talented young jumper from Sunne (SWE). Damoiselle Du Mesnil is new to this level (155) and has only ever jumped once at 150 level (here in Gothenburg last year).
4.	 <b>Colonello</b> <i>Johan-Sebastian Gulliksen</i>	4 9	44%	26%	633	His father (Geir) won the World Cup here in 2020. Having a career-best season. A win here would be his first major jump-off win at 5* 155/160 level.
5.	 <b>Evolution Ask DWB</b> <i>Soren Moeller Rohde</i>	1 7	14%	29%	628	Experienced Danish rider arrives here in good form. Evolution Ask DWB jumped clear and finished 6th in Bordeaux Grand Prix (160) two weeks ago.
6.	 <b>Caillan</b> <i>Rolf-Goran Bengtsson</i>	0 1	0%	28%	627	Won this in 2019, 2005 and 1996. Best chance for the home nation to lift the roof tonight. Seeking 4th win over a 30-year period.
7.	 <b>Blood Diamond Du Pont</b> <i>Julien Anquetin</i>	4 18	22%	31%	666	Horse and rider combination have tasted success in the Scandinavium with the Friday night win in 2023. This would be a bigger moment and they have the speed if they make the jump-off.
8.	 <b>EKA First Navy Jack</b> <i>Carl-Walter Fox</i>	1 5	20%	25%	556	Carl-Walter has once before jumped in Gotheburg at 155 and was clear. This 10 year old horse stepped up to 160 in 2025. Clear at 150 level in the EEF final in Avenches (2025).
9.	 <b>Dancing Queen</b> <i>Lars Kersten</i>	0 6	0%	30%	460	Lars won the World Cup here in 2024 as part of a magic 'double Dutch' weekend. That was with Hallilea. This looks a tougher ask.
10.	 <b>Quinoa De La Liniere</b> <i>Koen Vereecke</i>	0 8	0%	27%	675	Debut at Gothenburg for a very experienced rider. Over 60 rounds at 155 level and looking for his 20th clear tonight. This horse won a 150 class in Mechelen at Christmas. Had one down in a 155 in Hong Kong three weeks ago.
11.	 <b>Campai 3</b> <i>Eiken Sato</i>	2 7	29%	31%	631	Eiken took a 5* 155 win in Stuttgart in 2022. This would match his career pinnacle as a top-level win. This horse & rider 5th in Oslo equivalent (155 GP) last autumn.
12.	 <b>Alphajet DB</b> <i>Johanna Beckmann</i>	0 0			539	Experienced horse at 150 level. First time at Gothenburg for Johanna and looking for her first clear as a rider at 155 level.
13.	 <b>Key West</b> <i>Jodie Hall McAteer</i>	0 2	0%	25%	631	First appearance in the Scandinavium for Jodie. Key West has never before jumped at 155 level (now 11) but has 2 rounds at 160. Had one down in a 160 in Bordeaux last time out.
14.	 <b>Didi Z</b> <i>Anna Olsson</i>	0 0			520	A big step up for Didi Z - previous international rounds were at 140 level back in 2024.
15.	 <b>Kivali H</b> <i>Filippa Enmark</i>	0 0			539	Gotheburg debut for Filippa and a career first 155 class. Kivali H was in St Tropez in 2025 at 150 level primarily (one clear from three rounds).
16.	 <b>Vistogrand</b> <i>Denis Lynch</i>	6 24	25%	30%	692	Denis last landed a feature class win in this arena back in 2015. Looking for his first Gothenburg Trophy. Last Irish winner was Jessica Kurten in 2008.
17.	 <b>Pretty Woman Van't Paradijs N.O.P.</b> <i>Willem Greve</i>	7 22	32%	25%	722	Willem took this title in 2024 with Highway TN N.O.P. Joint 2nd favourite (10%) to land a second win in three years.
18.	 <b>Ciao Calimero</b> <i>Philip Svitzer</i>	0 0			520	Arrives here after a win in Lovsta Future Challenge class. Young Swedish rider who will have the thome crowd cheering him on.
19.	 <b>Cossinelle</b> <i>Felix Koller</i>	0 0			654	Cossinelle was 5th in a 4* 160 class in Salzburg in December. Previously campaigned with Alisa Danilova.

21.	 <b>Il Rossa Di Costa</b> <i>Joel Torstenson</i>	0 1	<b>0%</b>	34%	<b>484</b>	This horse had 9 penalties in this class last year but was clear (12th) in a 150 class here. 12 year old horse. Only third time in career at 155 level.
22.	 <b>Leviathan HS</b> <i>Lars Bak Andersen</i>	0 0			<b>520</b>	Leviathan HS is only nine and has never been above the 145 level in international competition. This will be a step up. Lars has a good record at the show with three clears from 7 previous rounds.
23.	 <b>Opaline De W&amp;S</b> <i>Petronella Andersson</i>	4 17	<b>24%</b>	25%	<b>614</b>	Petronella had her famous back-to-back Friday night wins in 2024/2025. Opaline was 2nd in a 155 in Rome last year and not a shock if they go one better here.
24.	 <b>Hermes De Vesquerie</b> <i>Kevin Staut</i>	0 0			<b>583</b>	Kevin is one of the busiest riders in the sport, and has jumped almost 500 rounds at 155 level alone since 2010. This horse won a 150 class in London but will want to bounce back after a disappointing three down in Amsterdam (150).
25.	 <b>Equine America Gentlemen</b> <b>Vh Veldhof</b> <i>Robert Whitaker</i>	1 7	<b>14%</b>	28%	<b>650</b>	This horse is now 20 and still jumping clears - often at the 150 level. Was a winner of 150 class in Amsterdam in January and 2nd in London in December. Jumped at 155 level (one down) in Aachen in 2025 and winner of Derby in Hickstead 2025. A horse to enjoy and a rider with a win already this week.
26.	 <b>Crack Blue</b> <i>Linda Heed</i>	0 0			<b>520</b>	This 15 year old horse was with Anna SKÅRBERG until 2022 and made a comeback with Linda in 2025. Jumped in Oslo at 140/145 last year but this will be a new test.
27.	 <b>Hellix Du Seigneur</b> <i>Kim Emmen</i>	3 13	<b>23%</b>	25%	<b>642</b>	This horse has plenty of 155 and 160 experience and jumped clear at 160 level in London late 2025. Keep an eye on time faults but certainly a contender.
28.	 <b>Million's Grey</b> <i>Thomas Ryan</i>	0 0			<b>515</b>	Young horse (now 9) and new to the level. Has showed very good form at 140/145 level in 2025 but this will be a new test. Thomas was on podium on Thursday.
29.	 <b>Conterno-blue PS</b> <i>Patrick Stuhlmeyer</i>	2 3	<b>67%</b>	25%	<b>671</b>	Experienced rider arriving with a horse in form. Conterno-blue PS has jumped clear in last four rounds before arriving here. Clear (4th) in Amsterdam Grand Prix and in a 150 class there. Clear (5th) in Leipzig at 155 in January. Clear in a 150 class in Mechelen. One to watch.
30.	 <b>Nivienne</b> <i>Carla Peterson</i>	0 0			<b>520</b>	Carla Peterson won the European Youngster Cup U25 final in Salzburg (Amadeus Horse Indoors) in December 2025 with this mare Nivienne. The victory was highly emotional as it came after a one-and-a-half-year, long injury break. Will be popular in Scandinavia tonight.
31.	 <b>Quebello D</b> <i>Adam Carey</i>	1 1	<b>100%</b>	34%	<b>633</b>	Adam Carey has jumped three 155 rounds in his career and been clear in all three (two with Quebello D). They jumped clear and finished 10th in this class last year.
32.	 <b>Rain Man</b> <i>Ivan Serrano Saez</i>	0 8	<b>0%</b>	27%	<b>602</b>	A first appearance at Gothenburg for this Spanish rider. This is his horse from the European Championships in 2025 and their first top level outing since then.
33.	 <b>Vitiki</b> <i>Yuri Mansur</i>	2 7	<b>29%</b>	26%	<b>719</b>	Vitiki is a Jump Off specialist with 10 clears from 14 Jump Off appearances at this level or higher (4 wins, 6 podiums). All eyes will be on the R1 to see if they make it. Yuri is looking to become the first Brazilian winner of the Gothenburg Trophy. Yuri is one of the most experienced riders in the field and over last 10 years here at Gothenburg has jumped in 3 155 rounds, clear in 2.
34.	 <b>Mr. Tac</b> <i>Harrie Smolders</i>	7 14	<b>50%</b>	23%	<b>726</b>	Mr Tac won this class with Victor Bettendorf in 2023. He made the JO with Harrie last year (finished 8th).
35.	 <b>Vivantas</b> <i>Philipp Schulze Topp hoff</i>	0 9	<b>0%</b>	33%	<b>547</b>	Vivantas is an experienced horse with almost 50 rounds at 150 level and above and still just 11. They were clear in a 150 class (13th) in Amsterdam already this year and on the podium there in the Grand Prix (160) in 2025. Jumped in this class last year and had one down (28th).

Hennessy had a good spell in mid 2025 with Global Champions clear rounds in Valkenswaard and Riesenbeck. They arrive here after some four fault rounds in Vienna (GC) in Sept 2025, a disappointing round in Rabat (18) and one down in Leipzig in January. 8 previous 155 rounds for Hennessy and 2 clears.
37.	 <b>Statis Conti</b> Rodrigo Giesteira Almeida	0 2	<b>0%</b>	28%	<b>518</b>	Experienced Portugese rider known for producing top level horses including Kafka van de Heffinck (first five-star Grand Prix in Athens), GC Chopin's Bushi (later became one of Denis Lynch's key Grand Prix partners). Won a 1.55 GP in Mechelen (2024) with Karonia L. First big outing for Statis Conti in 2026 after this horse had a spell with Bertram Allen in late 2025.

## What is the Elo rating?

*The Metric that Matters*

### THE GOLD STANDARD

Adapted from the world of Chess, this system weights every result against the strength of the opposition. It doesn't just count wins; it measures **difficulty**.

### PREDICTIVE VALUE

**Higher Elo** values mean **higher chances of jumping clear**.

### THE RECORD

The highest Elo rating was ever achieved was **822** by **King Edward** in 2024.
